GREEN IS CATCHING ON IN NORTHERN INDIANA

In the northeast corner of the State, recycling is catching on! Local cities and businesses are being recognized for their environmental efforts. The City of Ligonier received a Governor's Award for Environmental Excellence in 2009. The City reused and recycled materials from the demolition of an old wire plant located just north of the downtown area. As the building was being torn

down, bricks and other materials were salvaged and distributed nationwide; with only 5-10% of the building being landfilled. The original site will be re-developed as a river walk park and new fire station. The City also received a national Environmental Protection Agency award for taking recycling to a new level. This award was given in New Orleans in 2009. Rieke Packaging

Systems in Auburn, Indiana was also recognized for taking steps to improve their environmental impact. Rieke was inducted into the Environmental Stewardship Program for their continuous improvement efforts in reducing waste and protecting the environment.
